Projects to have on your radar

East 15th and Agate

Phase 2 of the Hamilton Walton Residence Hall Transformation Project

They're starting to look like buildings! Building C will be fully framed out and roofed by the end of August, followed by window installation. By the end of September, brick and exterior metal installation will be underway. On Building B, framing will continue and roof framing will begin in August. Exterior waterproofing will continue during August/September, and window installation will begin in early September.

Early Childhood Cares fence

An ornamental iron fence on the north and west sides of the off-campus EC Cares building will finish enclosing the building and its parking lot. The eight foot security fence will match existing fencing on the east and south sides of the property in style, and the current chain link fencing on the west side will be removed. This project should begin in mid-August and wrap up towards the end of September.

Note that Unpack the Quack begins on Monday September 19, but the largest move-in days are Thursday/Friday, with the bulk of the 5,500 student-residents moving in on these days.

Incoming student-residents have staggered appointment times to pick up keys and move into their residence halls for the 2022-2023 academic year, assisted by their families and UO staff and volunteers.

Traffic plans are in the works, with Housing working with Transportation Services, EPD and UOPD, and will be shared as the event approaches. Be prepared for roads on campus to be closed to all non-Unpack the Quack traffic. There may be amplified music at check-in locations during the day.
