Projects to have on your radar

Agate Street; 18th Avenue

WCH Oregon22 build-out

Near-neighbors may begin to see event build-out taking place along Agate Street, East 18th, and other spaces adjacent to Hayward Field. Early build-out will include temporary stands, a broadcast media compound, and back-of-house infrastructure. On June 28, Agate Street from 13th to 19th, and East 18th Avenue from University to Agate will both close to traffic. In July, most campus roads will have restricted access, and Agate Street will be closed to pedestrian traffic inside the secure perimeter after the 10th. (More WCH Oregon22 info on page 3)

In June, the project will largely be in the wood framing phase, with the tower crane continuing to lift panels into place. By the time the WCH Oregon22 event arrives in July, Building C (west building) will be mostly framed out to its full height of 4/5 stories. Exterior waterproofing will also start in late June.

The project will be shut down from July 8-25 due to WCH Oregon22.

The world's largest track & field event comes to the US for the first time July 15-24, at Hayward Field and Autzen Stadium! Athletes, media, and fans from 200+ nations will travel to the region for this event, hosted by a local organizing committee on behalf of World Athletics. Hayward Field will host two sessions per day on many of the competition days. Road events will take place on Martin Luther King Jr Blvd, with street closures expanding into Springfield for the marathons on Sunday July 17 and Monday July 18.
