Projects to have on your radar

15th and Agate Street

Hayward Field Visual Experience Board
Work on the new video board on the north end of the stadium is complete, and you may see operational testing. At roughly 5,080 square feet, it is the largest permanent video screen for a track and field stadium in the country. More info at hayward.uoregon.edu

15th and Agate Street

Phase 2 of the Hamilton Walton Transformation Project
You can see construction beginning at the former Walton Hall site, with demolition complete. This project is slated for completion in July 2023. Project information and weekly updated impact reports: housing.uoregon.edu/construction

Near the Central Power Station, Onyx St north of Franklin Blvd

Thermal Energy Storage Project
Construction progresses on the UO's new chilled water thermal energy storage tank installation, expected to be completed by October 2022. This 3-million gallon thermal energy tank will greatly add to the chilled water capacity for cooling campus buildings, and will help reduce the UO's peak electrical usage. In addition to the new storage tank, there will be cooling tower additions and control system and efficiency upgrades.
