US Indian Boarding Schools, Salvage Anthropology, and Basketry Collections in Oregon

Indigenous historian and anthropologist David Lewis (member of the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde) and historian Vera Keller explore one of the University of Oregon's early campus collections, now part of the Museum of Natural and Cultural History.

Ada Bradley Millican (1858-1927) donated almost 400 Native American works of art, many of which she collected during her six-year career working for the US Indian boarding schools in Utah, Arizona, and Washington and in collaboration with another collector, Howard Hall, superintendent of several boarding schools including Chemawa.

This talk situates these collecting activities at the intersection of the arts and crafts movement, cultural erasure via industrial education, and the University's interest in establishing settler narratives of progress.

# **NEXT GENERATION HOUSING**

Over the next 20 years, the University of Oregon is planning more high-quality, learning-centered residential communities on campus that are compatible with surrounding neighborhoods, provide a gentle transition between higher and lower intensity uses, and serve our growing student community.

To plan a variety of housing types that meet the needs of first-year students, undergraduates, graduates, and families, the UO is in the process of designing **two 800-bed residence halls that will be built on the southeast side of campus between 17th and 19th Avenue and Moss and Villard Streets**. The first residence hall is planned to be complete by Fall 2027, and the second residence hall is planned to be complete by Fall 2028.

A **right-of-way vacation** (transfer of ownership from the City of Eugene to the UO) for the portion of Moss Alley adjacent to university-owned property is necessary to build the Phase 1 residence hall. The application was submitted to the City of Eugene in late December. A public hearing regarding the vacation at a Eugene City Council meeting is expected to take place in May and a City Council vote is required to approve the vacation.

The vacation of Moss Alley will impact current traffic circulation pattern for trucks delivering items to UO's Central Kitchen facility on Moss Street.

# **CONSTRUCTION CORNER**

## **Knight Campus Building 2**

*Riverfront Parkway and Millrace Drive* 

Building façade and roofing system installations are underway and interior wall framing and building system installations are underway on all levels. The Knight Campus Building 1 north entrance and the pedestrian boardwalk between Building 1 and Millrace are both closed during the construction of the skybridge connecting Buildings 1 and 2. Riverfront Parkway remains open in all directions with occasional construction traffic. Completion is on schedule for Winter 2026.

### Kalapuya-Illihi Residence Hall

Moss St. and 17th Ave

Interior repairs to walls continue. Completion is on schedule for Fall 2025. Once back in use by students, Hamilton Complex will be decommissioned.

## Villard and University Halls "Heritage" Renovation Project

### W. 11th near Franklin Blvd

The UO's two oldest buildings are undergoing complete interior renovations and exterior restorations. Seismic upgrades are nearly complete, windows are off site to be refurbished, and roofing of University Hall is currently underway. Fencing on the perimeter of the site blocks some interior sidewalks; temporary detour walkways are in place. Completion is scheduled for Fall 2025.

### **UO Athletics Indoor Practice Facility**

### Leo Harris Parkway

In preparation for the construction of a new athletics practice facility west of Autzen Stadium in 2026, a portion of Leo Harris Parkway is being realigned. Leo Harris Parkway is temporarily closed to all traffic at the west end between MLK Blvd. and the new Eugene Science Center parking lot west of the footbridge to Alton Baker Park through summer 2025. Access to UO Athletics facilities, the Eugene Science Center, and Alton Baker Park is available from the east end of Leo Harris Parkway. The new parking lot adjacent to Eugene Science Center remains open.
